### **POLICY**

The Community of Student Representatives (CSR) is established as a forum for the discussion of student-related issues as they relate to policies and procedures and a networking body for student leaders across the College.

### **PROCEDURES**

1. There will be one all-college Community of Student Representatives (CSR) consisting of two representatives from each academic center.
2. Each center, under the direction of a designated coordinator of academic services, is responsible for developing a process for the selection of the center's student representatives. Additionally, each center may support its own local Community of Student Representatives.
3. Student representatives are appointed for the academic year. Student representatives may be re-appointed for a second year.
4. The responsibilities of the student representatives include: being available and willing to listen to student concerns; bringing student concerns to the Community of Student Representatives; soliciting student input on specific college-initiated issues, initiatives and student leadership opportunities; and attending CSR statewide meetings. Student Representatives will also be invited to serve on the Vermont State Colleges Student Association (VSCSA), and other committees requesting student feedback and participation.
5. At least once per the fall and spring semesters the Community of Student Representatives will meet with the dean of students and/or other college administrators.
6. General responsibilities for the Community of Student Representatives and its activities rest with the dean of students and/or his/her designee.
