POLICY

CCV recognizes outstanding academic achievement by awarding honors to eligible students each semester and upon graduation.

PROCEDURES

Semester Honors

In accordance with VSC Policy 111, Academic Data Management, CCV students who have earned 12 GPA credits in a semester are eligible to receive Dean's List or President's List honors.

In addition, each semester CCV Student Honors are awarded to CCV students who have earned 6-11 GPA credits in the semester and have a full-semester GPA of 4.0.

President's List, Dean's List, and CCV Student Honors shall not be awarded if an incomplete is outstanding when grades are reported, if a grade is changed, or if any grade from the semester is a W (withdrawal).

Graduation Honors

Graduation honors are awarded when a student completes a degree program at CCV and are recorded on a student's transcript

Criteria for graduation honors are:

- 1. At least 50% of total credits required for graduation (30 credits minimum) must be earned at the VSC.
- 2. Graduation honors require final, cumulative GPA as follows:

Cum laude: 3.50 Magna cum laude: 3.70 Summa cum laude: 3.90
