POLICY

Community College of Vermont is an open-admissions, non-residential, public college providing affordable education each semester at 12 locations statewide and online.

PROCEDURES

- 1. Tuition levels are set annually by the Vermont State Colleges Board of Trustees, and are charged on a per credit basis for credit-bearing courses.
- 2. Fee levels are set annually by the president of the college in accordance with Vermont State Colleges' guidelines and include a non-refundable registration fee, independent study, field experience, course-specific fees, and graduation fees.
- 3. Additional fees may be assigned when deemed appropriate by the college.
- 4. For non-credit training, special offerings, or contracted courses, the college reserves the right to set all fees and/or costs as it deems appropriate.
